

Metal discs are strong helpers when it comes to attaching our magnets. With their drilled and countersunk holes, they are ideal adhesive surfaces that can be screwed together seamlessly with a countersunk screw. The best thing about them is that they can also be easily mounted on non-magnetic surfaces, where they serve as a point of attraction for our magnet systems.

Important! Please note that the metal discs themselves are not magnetic, but merely act as a point of attraction for our magnets.
